For use with Arb Residues from gardens, orchards, churchyards, designated public open spaces such as parklands or trees, removed to ensure public safety.

1.1 Declaration

I declare that the material supplied to Sylvagen LTD:

Between the dates: 01st Jan 2021 and 31st Dec 2021

Derives only from Arboricultural Residue

Arboricultural residue may come from two sources;

Source 1

Trees removed from the Urban landscape such as gardens, orchards, churchyards, designated public open spaces or trees removed to ensure public safety, examples being Motorway and Railway verges, are outside forestry licencing regulation.

Arb residues falling in to this category are deemed to be sustainable and legal with no evidencing requirement apart from delivery documentation stating the source and supplier of the material.

Suppliers should be prepared to provide an affidavit confirming that the material supplied has originated from the urban landscape as specified above.

Source 2

Trees removed from clearance activities to create a built environment, examples being site clearance and construction works. These are outside forestry licencing regulation but will fall under planning consent.

Arb residues falling in to this category are deemed to be sustainable and legal when accompanied with evidence of planning consent and delivery documentation stating the source and supplier of the material.

*You, the supplier, confirm the material supplied to Sylvagen LTD meets the terms of this declaration and is not classified as a waste material, you confirm that it is suitable for use within none waste facilities including none **'WID' biomass facilities and processing sites.***
