



Logs/Offcuts Specification Sheet

General

Tree surgery rings, offcuts and noggins generally from arboricultural works and reductions etc.

Acceptable Material

All species are acceptable but if they are to be loaded onto one of our vehicles, they must be hand lifted from the root and a maximum of 1m long.

Contamination in Loads

Loads must be clean and substantially free from contamination or run risk of additional charges or immediate rejection from site.

For example, but not limited to: Arb chip, arb shred, non-virgin wood (waste wood all grades), fossil fuels, plastic, sand, rock, soil, stone, mud or other mineral elements, metal, litter, non-virgin wood, diseased timber, burnt material, annual crops, snow, ice and frozen structures.

Sylvagen retains the right to review and modify this specification. Reasonable notice will be given prior to any change of specification. In the event of a rejection any and all costs associated with rejection and disposal of the material will be borne by the supplier.
