

Shredded Arb Brash Specification Sheet

General

Arb Shred typically refers to waste generated from arboriculture activities, including tree trunks, branches, roots and other woody materials.

Acceptable Material

Shredded virgin brash

Where any part of the tree, including branches, trunk and roots are put through a shredder and the material is produced from clearance, forestry or arboricultural work and shredded to between 10-100mm

Contamination in Loads

Loads must be clean and substantially free from contamination or run risk of additional charges or immediate rejection from site.

For example, but not limited to: Non-virgin wood (waste wood all grades), fossil fuels, plastic, sand, rock, soil, stone, mud or other mineral elements, metal, litter, non-virgin wood, diseased timber, burnt material, snow, ice and frozen structures.
